Fun Fact

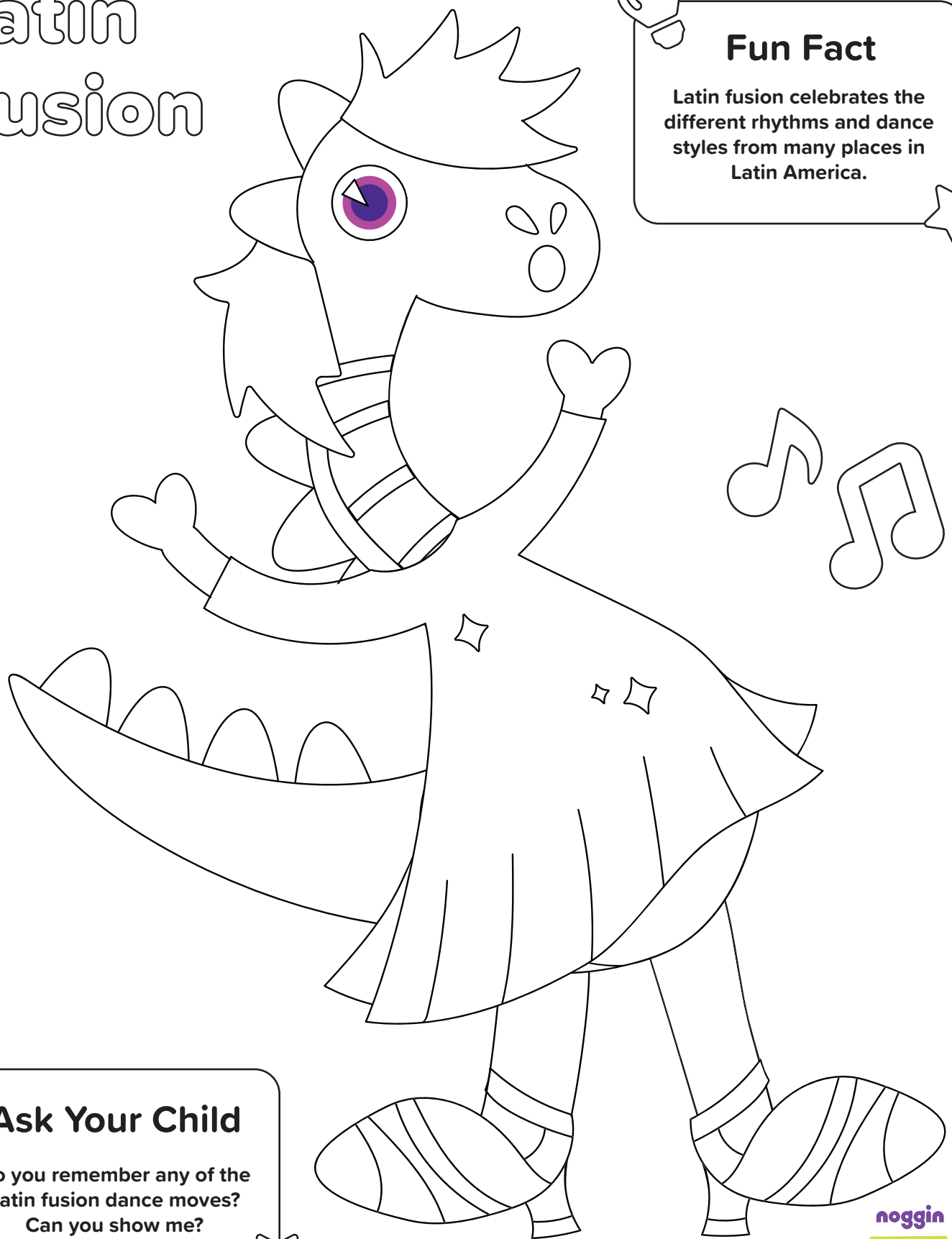
A mentor to Alvin Ailey, Lester Horton created a dance style to bring together dancers of all backgrounds.
